Robert Cervero

PROFESSOR EMERITUS, UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY, USA



Prof Robert Cervero is currently Professor Emeritus of City and Regional Planning at the University of California, Berkeley, in the United States. He is co-editor of Access magazine, a consultant with the World Bank, and a visiting professor at NYU-Abu Dhabi.

One of the most cited planning and transportation scholars globally, he has written numerous books and papers, including the recently released *Beyond Mobility* (2017), and was a contributing author to IPCC's Fifth Assessment on climate change and UN-Habitat's 2013 Global Report on Sustainable Mobility.

Professor Cervero will present '**Transit Oriented Development for Sustainable, Efficient, and Equitable Urban Futures**', where he will talk about Transit Oriented Development for Sustainable, Efficient, and Equitable Urban Futures. Socially inclusive TOD and transport initiatives are critically important to ensuring shared prosperity, and for complete, affordable communities to emerge. Prof Cervero will share experiences in London, San Francisco, and Bogota where socially inclusive TOD has been successful.
